Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para A of Part A of Schedule III of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024, we inform you that the Additional Commissioner of Customs, Nhava-Sheva, Maharashtra vide its Order dt. 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025, has levied redemption fine, differential duty and penalty u/s 114A of the Customs Act, 1962, for alleged misclassification.
